welcome you people - the well wishers - sitting at such a long  
distance but having soft corner for Indian Society.

The contents of the letter have been read out by me  
and the details brought out into notice of all the children in  
the school Prayers and the class room too. The young boys/  
girls do understand the things. The younger students of  
K.C. do not. Soon, every one, including the guardians, will  
realize the issue when newspapers will give its sight in  
every home and the society as a whole. It is our first  
endeavour that have ever been given in the society for  
such causes.

The children and the staff too join me to convey their  
heart felt thanks and sincere love to all the brothers there. They  
will be too happy to see and meet you people here. The gentlemen  
can personally see/talk to the children and enquire whatever info  
is left behind or needed. Really it would give a great pleasure  
to all of us.

I find that one name of Kamari Usha d/o Nagashwar  
which appeared at no 17 of my list is missing from your list  
now received with above letter. Other 20 names are K.C. Besides,  
few more children have joined the school in July 2003. I will  
be trying to send their photographs and other requisite details  
soon with our next quarterly report.

Quarterly report for Q/E Sep 03  
ASHA SIKSHAN SANSTHAN

A Basic Primary School in the name of ASHA Shikshan Sansthan functions in Mauza Babhnuli (Gram Sabha Bishanpura) for the last 5 years. There was no aid earlier from any sources. The Fishermen, Rajbhar and Bangora (Bali) Community are covered by this school. A five member committee from the community consisting of Shri Muni, Gajathar, Dulichay, Shri Chand and Nigam deals with internal matter of the school.

People like D.P. Babbarh, Jay Shree, Vidhi, Samruze, Siroa etc from Asha Abroad visited this place earlier in the past few years. In order to manage the education properly, a proposal was sent abroad as discussed in Asha's half yearly meetings earlier. The expenses consisting the school parts appears to have been considered by Asha Austin. They have recently sent \$ 1206 as evident from their letter of 05 Aug 03. The money is awaited from our Kaithi Centre. The expenditure details will be sent after receipt of the money and necessary expenses are carried out. Names of 30 children sponsored have been intimated by Asha Chapter under SAC Programme. The students from LKG to 5th std get education at a combined place.

In that, there are young girls too who are fond of Hand skills and other arts necessary for self reliance. In fact it comes under our motto to make the students self reliant. For this, we propose to give training/education for various hand skills. To start with there would soon be a Tailoring/Cutting/Sewing/Knitting Centre in the school campus.

Presence of one lady teacher to cope up thru and other ladies affairs of the school and also in the community was necessary. There being no qualified girl available in the community, Kumari Recha (Brajendra Bhai's daughter), a qualified girl also in various hand skills, was brought in the school last year. She left her Graduation class last year only as the College is located 25 KM away at District Ballia and her Guardian did not manage the show properly at such distance. It was also necessary and unavoidable due to social and other administrative causes affecting the girls in the Indian Society what to speak of the communities like ours which lacks education. She will, however, be replaced soon after some-one is located/trained by us in the Community. The another teacher Shri Babu Lal aged about 28 years is an "Intermediate Science" and a sincere technician and laborious teacher at school.

Besides the names and details already submitted last year, few more children have joined the school in current session commencing from July 2003 to June 2004. The requisite details and marks obtained in various subjects will be submitted after our six-monthly examination is over. It is due in December 2003.
