There will be Trimester Examinations will be conducted for 8th and 9th Standard students i.e. in the month of September, December and April in a year. Students must pass in all these Semester examination, otherwise they will be considered as failed. In these type of examination, at an average of 85% to 90% students successfully pass in the examination. The students who have failed in the exams they will be readmitted in the same class.

In the Case of 10th Standard (S.S.L.C), the Karnataka Higher Education Examination Board will conduct the exams in the month of March of

each and every Academic Year. In those exams, the students appearing from our School, 70 to 80% of the students shall successfully pass in the said exams. The supplementary exams shall be conducted by the Board in the month of June of every academic year for the students who have failed in the Annual Exams.

We used to call Parents Meet 2-3 times in a year. In those meetings -

- 1) we learnt student's behaviour with their parents.
- 2) Studying hours of the students in their home.
- 3) In which way students will cooperate their parents in household works.
- 4) Playing time of the students
- 5) Behaviour of the students with their friends.

In each and every month of December, our Teachers and the Head Master used to visit the houses of the students personally and they advise the parents to take care of their children to concentrate on studies.

By identifying the difficulties faced by the students in their respective subjects, remedial classes will be conducted every day. Our School has also made arrangements for study in the School premises between 4 to 5 p.m.. Necessary suggestions will be given to the students in their curricular activities. Extreme care will be taken towards Sports and our students got Awards in Taluk and District Level Sports Meet by participating. We have also opened Science Club and Swami Vivekananda Studying Centre in our school.
