Introducing....
The Perpetual Sponsorship Scheme

This month we introduce the Perpetual Sponsorship Scheme. This scheme guarantees the perpetual sponsorship of one child annually with a donation of Rs. 2,00,000.

Here is how it works!

In this scheme donors donate a sum of Rs. 2,00,000 which will remain in a fixed deposit under Gnanodaya School, the interest of which will be used towards sponsorship of one child every year. This model ensures a sustainable future for the children and the school. A sum of Rs. 2,00,000 is sufficient to guarantee education and hostel expenses for one child every year (on a perpetual basis).

Our goal is to collect enough donations under the perpetual sponsorship scheme to assure 150 children an education every year.
